# Message from the Secretary

Respected President, members, Governing Council and persons present here I on behalf of Purbacal Ananda Foundation well come you all in todays AGM.

Our society registered on 20/9/2005 at Kolkata having regd no : S/1L/32097. It is situated in a remote village, Purokonda of Bankura Distt of WB state. The organisation is also listed in Planning Commission Partnership System WB/2009/0005891. This organisation is also registered in Bankura District NGO registrar in Sl No 65. This organisation has been registered in Income tax rule 12A & 80G.

PAF started its work in service of orphan and needy children in the year 2005 with 4 children in a mud made house. To day we have pucca buildings for children. At Present we are taking care of 19 female children & 13 male children. The organisation started in the line of " JIBE PREM KORE JAI JON , SAI JON SEBECHE ISWAR".

Our main objective is upbringing of Orphans, children of sex workers, children whose parents are serving imprisonment, needy and disadvantaged rural children thru education and vocational skill so that these children are self reliant and lead a life as a responsible citizen of society.

PAF believe in making an orphan & needy children self sufficient for their future development & rehabilitation which can be achieved only through education & vocational training.

We started our journey since 2005 and has come up to this level due to concerted effort of all our members, staff and the resident children along with our valued patronisers. It is our team work that made it happen. The electricity connection of our organisation has been converted from high tariff commercial to very low tariff Public utility type due to sincere efforts of Sri Gautam Ghosh, Sri Nadia Indu Biswas. Also I would like to mention that the kind consideration shown by the WBSEDL officials is worth mentioning about the change of electricity consumer category. We are duly registered as a FCRA holder from ministry of Home Affairs as because of relentless effort of Sri Gautam Ghosh.

We have come a long way in last 10 years and you have watched the progress of our Ashram and its activity. I would like to thank all those who have directly or indirectly helped us to come to this position .

I would like to render my deep gratitude to the Founderl Member Smt Sima Banerjee whose sad demise has created a void in our Governing Council. I pray to almighty that her soul may rest in peace.

Now I place some of the important activities taken place in our organization during the year.

M/S Alloy Steel plant of Durgapur has donated us 10 nos of SS table and 20 nos of SS bench for our dinning hall for the children. The Ashram main entrance gate was in a dilapidated condition and it has taken a good shape due to the kind consideration by M/s Stollberg of Durgapur. The Ashram premises has been covered under CCTV surveillance owing to the generous contribution from members of Bengali club of Sharjah, this has a great impact on security aspects of the ashram. M/S Trans Damaodar Truck Owners of Barjora has donated a sum of Rs 100000 and I personally thank Sri Ashutosh Mukherjee, MLA for his leading initiative.

Our text book library has been enriched with the books donated by Sri Rana Das, his philanthropic mindset has overwhelmed us. On the occasion of Sharodia Durgatshov 2015, Sri Arun Agarwal ( Barjora), Sri Kallol Seal ( Aerotropolis) Smt Pratima Dutta donated new clothes to the children. The ashram is being gifted monthly in terms of kind donation from Sri Surya Kesh , Sri Arun Agarwal, Dr Partha Pal, and grocery by Sandip Bhattacharya. There are some regular monthly donors in cash by sri Arun Bandopadhaya, Dr Ipshita Pal, Sri Gautam Ghosh, and many more.

Rock climbing course was organized at Susunia Hill, Bankura for the first time by kind patronization from Bhadrakali Padatik club, Uttarpara, Hoogly. I really like to mention that Sri Dipankar Ghosh and his team has done a excellent job in nurturing our novice children and giving them a wide opening in such adventure sports.

Presently we are running with 32 children but as per present infrastructure we can accommodate 50 children and for that I put forward my earnest request to all of us to work more diligently , raise fund and take the organisation to a new height.

In order to establish and self reliant, we have to introduce vocational courses for our children as well as for young residents of the nearby villages. There is a dearth of health services and a immediate need to establish a health centre in the community for our children as well as for community residents. The present library requires expansion with new books. The after school coaching which has been discontinued for quite some due to paucity of funds should be started as soon as possible. I earnestly request you all to strive hard and start the above activities. I strongly believe that with continuous support and blessing from you and all associated, I am confident a that all the above requirements can be brought to reality.

I would like to mention that the organisation & staff are working round of clock to fulfill the mission and establish the rights of the children. In this endeavour we also earned most precious thing of life i.e. your trust & love with the children and organization. I once again assure that your trust and love will never go down and we will give you more chance to feel happy and proud for supporting the children of PAF.

I am really thankful to all such persons, organisations and corporates who are associated with us as supporters, well wishers and donors and without which we will not be able to achieve as what we are now.

While concluding, I heartily thank the present members, Governing council for the year 2014-15 and seek their blessing for the coming year. I hereby place the AGM report of 2014-15.

# CHILD PROTECTION POLICY:

## **Applicable to Donors/ Sponsors / Guests**

- A. Purbchal Ananda Foundation should be notified in advance of any sponsor/donor agency visits.
- B. Gifts are never to be offered directly to an individual child
- C. Must not give treat to any individual child or take any child out on any kind of excursion. If it is done in a group then prior intimation in terms of letter of permission will be required and relevant staff must accompany.
- D. Consent of the children and authority is necessary before images can be taken
- E. Images should never be taken when children are dressing, bathing, sleeping, etc.
- F. Interaction with children is only allowed at designated times and in the presence of appropriate staff
- G. With case studies, no personal information or true identity should be disclosed
- H. Must wear clothes that are appropriate in the local context
- I. Never use abusive language or behave in a sexually provocative manner in the presence of children or staff
- J. Recognize the children by his or her name and do not use derogative names or nicknames.
